

BYLAWS - BEAVERHEAD COUNTY PLANNING BOARD

Adopted October 1974, Revised 9/75, 12/75, 3/77

Article 1-Authorization

The Beaverhead County Planning Board was created in accordance with Sec. II-J801, P.C.M. 1947, as amended, by a resolution, passed May 1972 by the Board of County Commissioners, Beaverhead County, Montana; and by a resolution passed February 1974 by the City Council of the City of Dillon.

Article 2-Authorization

The jurisdictional area for the Board shall be all the county, Montana, except the Town of Lima.

The purpose of the Board shall be to plan and promote the orderly growth and development of the land within Beaverhead county by giving primary consideration to the most beneficial use of the land within Beaverhead county, assisting the local units of government to make adequate provisions for utilities, streets, highways, conveniences, public health, safety, general welfare, education, recreation; recognizing the present and future needs for agricultural, residential, recreational, commercial and industrial land uses, conserving, stabilizing and protecting the present and future use and value of the land; providing healthful surroundings for life. The

Board is an advisory board to the Board of County Commissioners and the City Council of Dillon. (Sec. 11-3801, RCJ 1947), Article LJ -Definitions

County Commissioners, as used in these bylaws, means the Board of county Commissioners, Beaverhead county, Montana.

City Council, as used in these bylaws, means the Council of the City of Dillon, Montana. .I

Article tj -Membership,

A. Selection -Members shall be appointed by the County Commissioners with city representatives recommended by the City Council of Dillon.

B. Terms of Office -Members shall be appointed for two years.

Reappointment to expiring terms shall be made by the County Commissioners by written notice to the Planning Board.

C. ~-Q..~ -Unexcused absences from more than three regular meetings, or absences from more than 1/2 of the meetings in the year unless because of illness shall result in disqualification from the Board and appointment of a substitute member by the appropriate governing body. Only the Chairman or Acting Chairman may authorize absences. ,

D. Resignations and Vacancies -Resignations from the Board ~ "...'

shall be in writing for the Chairman who will then

notify the governing body of the resignation. If a resignation occurs on the Board shall be filled within 60 days for the unexpired portion of the term, by the governing body having appointed them.
